“CHANGE YOUR THOUGHTS AND IMPROVE YOUR OUTCOMES: An update on protocols, products and treatment options” 3 CEUs

Updated protocols assist us in determining our patient’s specific needs. As we move towards a more collaborative profession, we need to embrace these updates to identify those needs. We are presented with continuous challenges of new advances in products and technology and their use in dentistry and are in need of information to determine when and how to add them into our armamentaria. As professionals providing health services, our perception of product use along with protocols needs to be discussed with our team as well as the interdisciplinary referrals we have. The process of care (assessment, diagnosis, treatment planning, implementation, evaluation and documentation) requires a comprehension of protocols, products and treatment options and how they are to be utilized.

This course will provide information for the clinicians to be able to:

- Modify diagnosis assistance with the team and rationale for changes in assessment forms and diagnostic tools.
- Distinguish which new-to-market products should be brought into your practice.
- Integrate materials and products for a variety of uses in the dental office from infection control, dental hygiene therapy, patient communication and instrumentation.
- Develop effective communication with patients and assist in the business of the dental practice.
- Formulate strategies that incorporate efficiency in patient treatment for more productive scheduling.

“NO PAIN, THEIR GAIN: Ergonomics and Effective patient care” 3 CEUs

This course will review ergonomics, increase awareness of repetitive motion problems and how they may be impacted by operatory design, instrument utilization/design/selection/sharpening skills/options and a variety of other issues. A clinician’s ability to identify ergonomic issues is directly related to improved patient care. Detailed information will be offered on a variety of products as well as design options to best allow you to fulfill your requirements in relating to the total health of your patients. Join us for an opportunity to share, learn and critique all of the above, to gather information from your peers, which you can then incorporate into your daily practice routine!

This course will provide information for the clinicians to be able to:

- Design a program to enhance patient treatment while identifying ergonomic needs to provide increased quality care.
- Identify and recognize instruments available to select from for a variety of patient conditions and improved clinical outcomes.
- Distinguish habits that lead to repetitive movement which may cause harm to the clinician’s instrumentation abilities.
- Interpret specifics for care of instruments impacting instrument longevity and accuracy of utilization.
