HOW TO REGISTER FOR ANNUAL SESSION:

ALL STUDENTS interested in attending the ODHA Annual Session **MUST REGISTER** to attend!

1. ONLINE EVENT REGISTRATION ONLY.

Each student attending Annual Session, even just to present during Poster Sessions or as a guest, must complete an online registration.

- Student registration is important to the success of Annual Session. Obtaining accurate numbers of participants will allow for appropriate event, food, and seating planning.
- **REGISTER EARLY!** ALL registrations after November 1st will be treated as on-site registrations and will incur a late fee. Meals cannot be guaranteed after that date.
- **CANCELLATION POLICY:** Cancellations must be in writing to admin@odha.net. All approved refunds will be assessed with a possible service charge and processed within two weeks after the event. A full refund will be granted if the request is received by **November 1st, 2024**.

2. Student Registration cost is **\$10.00**.

Students are able to select a FREE student lunch Sat Nov 16th, as well as free events including IOH fundraiser, and S'mores session. Students are required to pay for any events they select that require meal tickets (Legislative Luncheon, New Officer Luncheon.) These meals must be ordered in advance and are not available during onsite processing. **Purchased meal event tickets must be picked up at the ODHA onsite registration table.**

- **PAYMENT METHOD.** Payment is expected upon online registration. Visa or MasterCard is required and processed through GoDaddy payments. *Note: Registration is not complete until registration is paid in full.*

4. **REGISTRATION DESK CHECK-IN.** A staffed onsite registration desk is available throughout the weekend (see schedule). All participants, *including students*, must check in at the registration desk upon arrival even if pre-registered. Saturday registration desk check-in will be located in the Ohio Event Center.

Student Informative Poster Presentation Competition at

Ohio Dental Hygienists' Association's 2024 Annual Session in

The Informative Poster Presentations are not original research but are required to be presented in a tabletop, tri-fold board format. **As a reminder, Table Clinics are no longer allowed, and all non-original research is required to be presented as an Informative Poster Presentation.** If you have any questions about any rules and regulations for an Informative Poster Presentation, please contact the Poster Session Committee at ODHAPosterSessions@gmail.com.

The Informative Poster Presentation gives students the opportunity to raise awareness about a theory, service or trend in dental hygiene practice. This is a competition and will be both judged and scored. First, second and third place will be awarded.

Informative Poster Presentation

2. What is an Informative Poster Presentation?

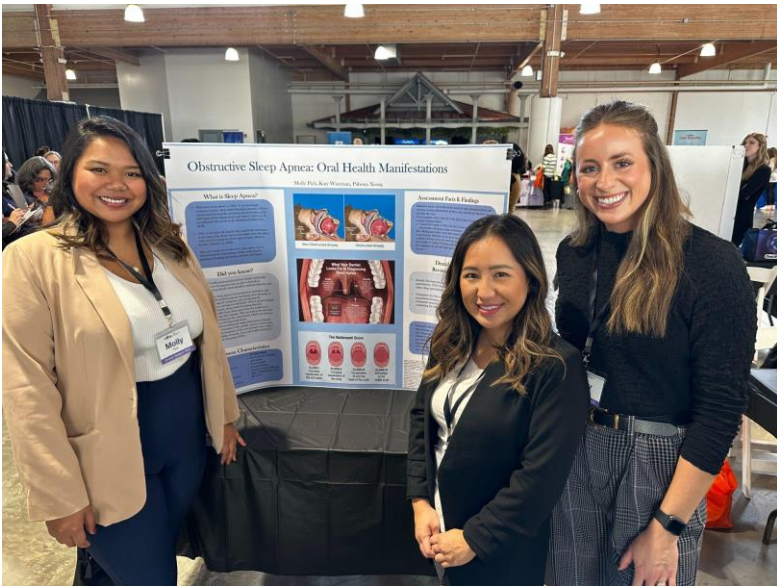
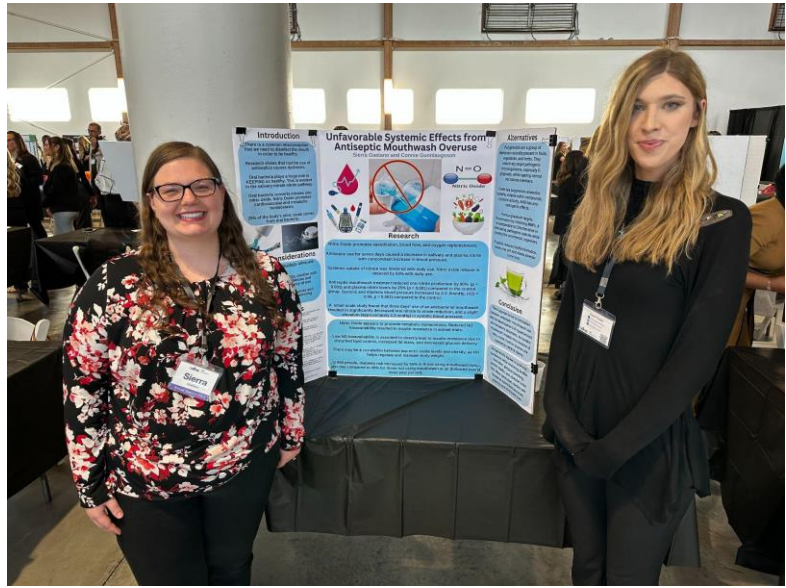
An **Informative Poster Presentation** is a presentation using oral communication and a professional poster to inform, clarify, and/or review material on a specific topic. An Informative Poster Presentation is **NOT original research**.

An Informative Poster presents useful and timely information in an original, interesting manner. This information may be a technique, theory, service, trend, or expanded opportunity in the practice of dental hygiene and/or the broader realm of oral and systemic health. Your Informative Poster should be focused, clear, and concise to provide information quickly and stimulate attention and interest. An Informative Poster is not an exhibit of materials.

3. Criteria for Preparing Your Informative Poster Presentation

1. Identify a theme or topic for your poster presentation.
2. Research your topic thoroughly and have reference documentation available.
3. Be prepared for questions and discussion.
4. Be prepared to communicate the information clearly within the allotted seven minutes. Practice your presentation so that you can discuss the key points without reading directly from note cards.
5. Prepare your poster to effectively communicate and supplement what you are saying. Avoid using sensationalized comments or images. The presentation should be professional and based on sound science and qualified references.
6. Practice your presentation with friends and colleagues. Ask for constructive criticism.

Rules and Regulations for Informative Poster Presenters

1. All presenters must be student members of ADHA at the time of the application deadline to participate in the Informative Poster Presentation during ODHA's Annual Session.
2. Up to **four presenters** are allowed for each poster.
3. Professional attire is required. Please keep in mind that presenters will be standing during the entire judging process. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
4. Displaying a dental hygiene program name or name tag during judging is strictly prohibited. Do not wear name tags with school affiliation. Those who do not comply will be disqualified from the competition.
5. Names may be displayed on the poster itself but must be covered up with non-transparent tape before and during the judging period.
6. Presentations must not exceed seven minutes. A two to three-minute question and answer portion will follow after concluding the presentation.
7. Trade names on products and or instruments are allowed to be identified.
8. Drug names are allowed to be identified by their trade, commercial, or product name. However, drug names must be referenced by their generic name or chemical makeup following the initial statement of the trade, commercial, or product name.
9. Posters will be judged by three randomly assigned judges.
10. Advertising matter, commercial promotion and solicitation of sales of any type are prohibited.
11. Posters must be confined to the size of 4' x 8', attached to a tri-fold board and in landscape layout.

Failure to comply with these rules and regulations will disqualify the poster from active competition and it will not be judged.

Student Research Poster Presentation Competition at

Ohio Dental Hygienists' Association's 2024 Annual Session in
Newark, OH, at the Cherry Valley Hotel.

The Research Poster Presentations give students the opportunity to show off the original research that they have done during their undergraduate career. This is a competition and will be both judged and scored. First, second and third place will be awarded.

- 1. All applications must be received by October 5th, 2024.**

Requirements

Presenters are required to be present at following events at ODHA's Annual Session:

- The Open Viewing & Competition on Saturday, November 16th, 2024 from 1-3 p.m.

Competitors are required to wear professional business attire to all related events (slacks, skirts, blazers, etc.)

- 2. What is a Research Poster Session?**

A **Research Poster** is a presentation of an original research study. Posters incorporate visual media and original data that reflect an area of ADHA's National Dental Hygiene Research Agenda.

During the competition, student presenters will have ten minutes with each judge, seven minutes to formally present the elements of their poster, and two to three minutes to answer questions. At the Poster Presentation Session, presenters will have the opportunity to discuss their poster with attendees at ODHA's Annual Session.

3. Below are the objectives for each Research Poster and its presenters:

1. Clearly define the purpose for the research study.
2. Identify and outline the research methodology
 - a. Design: survey, focus groups, etc.
 - b. Quantitative v. qualitative.
 - c. Procedures: describe intervention and control if experimental.
 - d. Sampling: random, snowball, sample size, demographics, etc.
 - e. Statistical tests employed.
3. Describe the results, including statistical data analysis. Should include percentages and/or p-values, etc.
4. Clearly state how the conclusions or findings are supported by the results of the research.
5. Prepare and practice your oral presentation with friends and colleagues. Ask for constructive criticism.
6. Be prepared for questions and discussion.

4. Below is the required structure for each Research Poster:

1. Title (clear, scientific, concise, and relates to the topic)
 - Ex.: "Evaluation of Resources for an Interactive Infection Control Instructional Program"
 - "Point-of-Care HbA1c Screening Predicts Diabetic Status of Dental Patients"
2. Problem
 - Ex.: "The number of caries in children and adolescents is an oral health crisis..."
 - Ex.: "Access to care is a global issue..."
3. Objectives
 - The objective should be clear and concise.
 - Studies with more than one objective should differentiate primary versus secondary.
4. Methodology and Statistics
 - Study design needs to be clearly stated, such as cross-sectional study, randomized controlled study, split-mouth design, survey, etc.
 - Be specific on subject criteria, number of subjects included, whether it was a convenience sample, or if subjects were screened and randomized into groups.
 - Describe intervention, survey, test product and control where appropriate.
5. Results
 - Provide numerical data that clearly communicates the findings in the study.
 - Include differences from baseline and between groups as needed
 - Clearly state the significance by providing p-value, percentages, and/or other statistical findings appropriate for study design.
6. Conclusions
 - Make sure conclusions clearly relate to the objective of the study.
 - Avoid adding superfluous or anecdotal information.

Rules and Regulations for Research Poster Sessions

1. All presenters must be student members of ADHA at the time of the application deadline to participate in the Student Research Poster Sessions during ODHA's Annual Session.
2. Up to **four presenters** are allowed for each research poster presentation.
3. Presenters must have been directly involved in conducting the research study presented.
4. Professional attire is required. Please keep in mind that presenters will be standing during the entire judging process. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
5. Displaying a dental hygiene program name or name tag during judging is strictly prohibited. Be sure to turn your name tag around during the judging process. Those who do not comply will be disqualified.
6. Names may be displayed on the poster itself but must be covered up with non-transparent tape prior to and during the judging period.
7. Presentations must not exceed seven minutes. A two to three-minute question and answer portion will follow after concluding the presentation.
8. Advertising matter, commercial promotion and solicitation of sales of any type are prohibited.
9. Drug names are allowed to be identified by their trade, commercial, or product name. However, drug names must be referenced by their generic name or chemical makeup following the initial statement of the trade, commercial or product name.
10. Presenters must supply all materials except the billboard.
11. Charts, posters, and diagrams must be constrained to the size of 4' x 8', attached to a tri-fold board and in landscape layout.
12. Research poster sessions will be judged by three randomly assigned judges.

Failure to comply with these rules and regulations will disqualify the poster from active competition and it will not be judged.

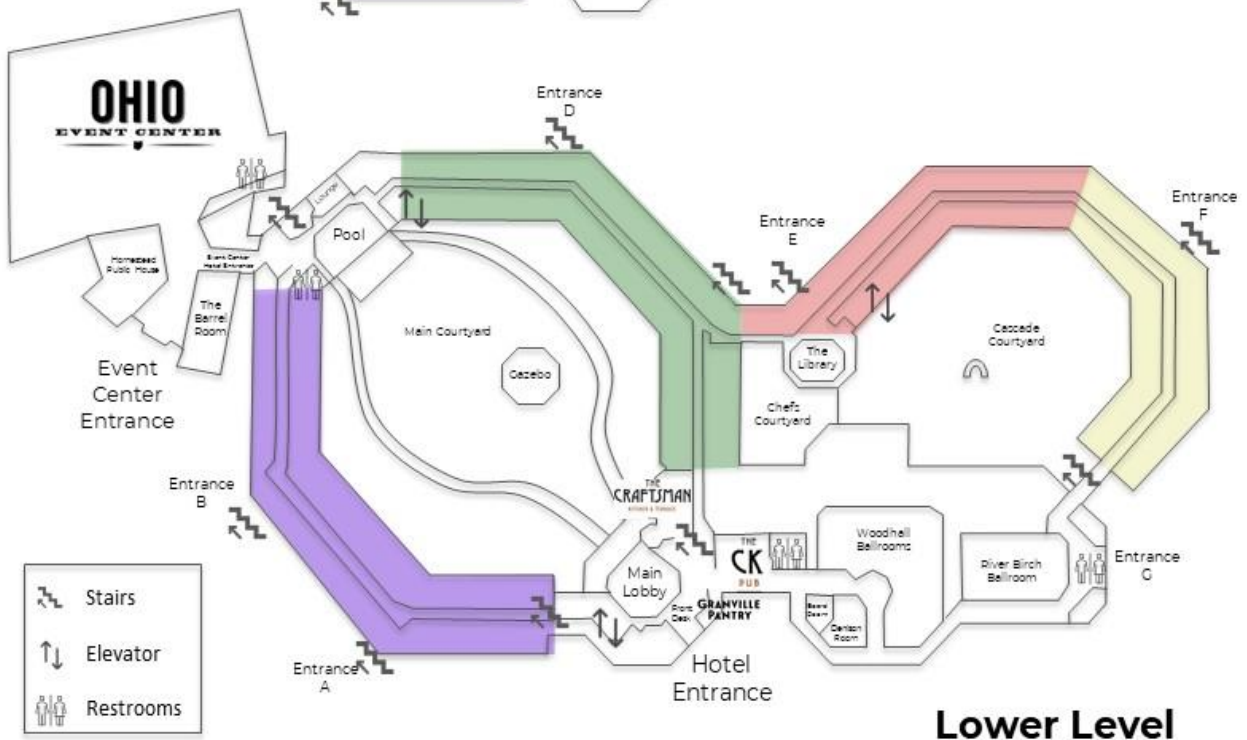
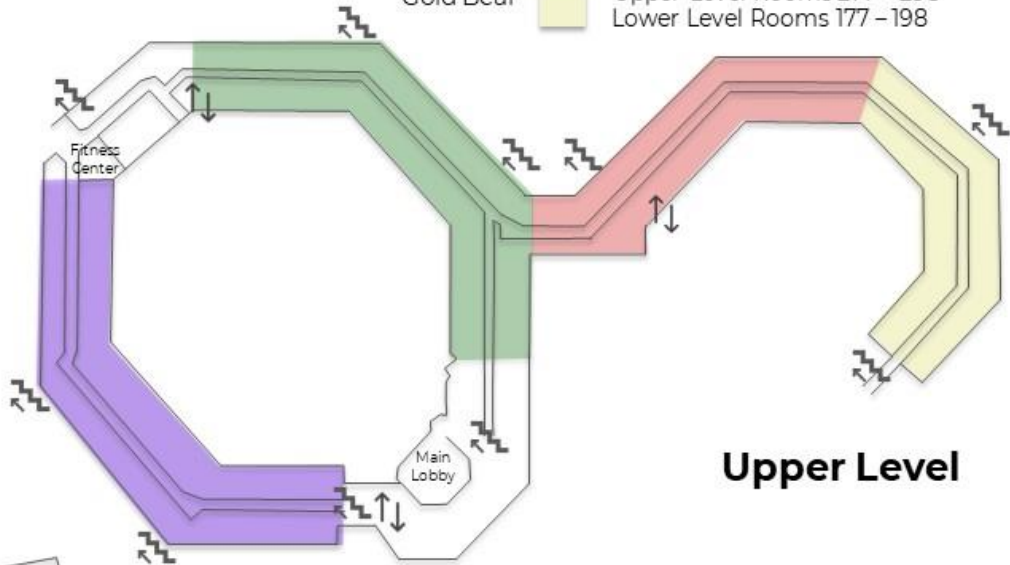

The Ohio Dental Hygienists' Associations' Christopher Simmons Student Scholarship 2024

1. Purpose

The ODHA Scholarship of \$500 is awarded to the second-year dental hygiene student to assist in financing their dental hygiene education.

2. Selection Criteria

- Scholastic ability (2.5 minimum)
- Professionalism
- Financial need Student
- Chapter of ADHA involvement – potential for future professional contribution

3. Procedure

- All interested second-year or senior dental hygiene students may make an application for the scholarship. The applications should be emailed to the ODHA student council chair, named on the application form. Email deadline for submitting application is **October 1st, 2024**.
 - ODHA scholarship selection committee will mask all applications.
 - Criteria Review forms will be utilized for standardization.
 - The council chair or the administrative assistant will tally the scholarship committees' responses, which will determine the scholarship recipient.
 - Must be emailed by Student ADHA advisor to be eligible.
 - The scholarship can be presented by the component trustee at the state Annual Session.

LOUISE M. BARRETT STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP 2024

Louise M. Barrett was passionate about the profession of dental hygiene the moment she graduated from The Ohio State University in 1958 and received her dental hygiene license. Prior to attending college, Louise proudly served two years in the U. S. Air Force. Louise was a past president of the Dayton Dental Hygienists' Association and a two-term past president of the Ohio Dental Hygienists' Association. She also served many years as Sergeant of Arms for the Ohio Dental Hygienists' Association. As a respected ODHA member, she was elected to serve as Delegate to ADHA numerous times. She befriended and mentored many dental hygienists throughout the state. Her laugh, smile, friendship, and never knowing a stranger was her gift to all of us.

Description of Louise M. Barrett ODHA Student Scholarship:

Established in 2018, this scholarship honors Louise M. Barrett, RDH, for her years of service and contribution to the profession of dental hygiene. Applicants must be enrolled in an Ohio associate or baccalaureate dental hygiene program and must have completed a minimum of one year; be a student member of the American Dental Hygienists' Association; display an overall cumulative grade point average of at least a **3.0** on a 4.0 scale; demonstrate personal and professional qualities reflecting those of Ms. Barrett. Applications for this annual scholarship must be electronically submitted by the stated deadline to the current ODHA Chairperson of Student Council. OHIO DENTAL HYGIENISTS' ASSOCIATION LOUISE M. BARRETT STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP 2024

Purpose
